III. How does the TDK Conference take place?

- detailed guide -

In the following guide, we describe in detail how the TDK Conference takes place.

What happens before the Conference?

After you have submitted your TDK thesis and related documents in full, the evaluation process begins. Two evaluations will be made of the submitted papers according to specific criteria, which you can find here: https://gktdk.uni-miskolc.hu/files/17197/ertekelo_lap_irasbeli2021.docx These evaluations will basically help the work of the jury, but after the Conference you can also view the evaluations of your thesis.

Based on the submitted papers, we form sections, which usually contain 5-10 papers on similar topics. Information about the schedule of the sections can always be found in the program booklet, which is available on the TDK website of the faculty, among the current calls.

At the same time, you can start putting together the presentation that you will present at the Conference. You can create your presentation in PowerPoint, prezi.com, or other presentation software. We recommend that when you are done with it, be sure to show it to your consultant and ask for his professional opinion! Believe me, a lot depends on the oral presentation and it really does matter what kind of presentation you will come up with!

What happens at the Conference?

In the public section, papers must be presented to a jury of at least three members. After the opening of the conference, the chairman of the jury will present the order of presentation of the papers based on the previously determined ones, and accordingly invite the authors to present the research results contained in the thesis.

You will have 15 minutes to give your presentation. During the lecture, the student presents the subject, methods and results of the research in a free style (PowerPoint, prezi.com, etc.). Please dress appropriately for the occasion, even if there will be online sessions!

Then the jury and those present discuss the thesis, ask the author questions, add additions and comments to the work. If you're curious, you can also check out how the jury scores oral presentations:

After getting acquainted with the papers, presentations, oral presentations and written opinions, after hearing all the papers nominated in the section, the jury decides in closed session on the result and the entry to the OTDK.

What happens after the Conference?

After the TDK Conference, the results will be announced and the diplomas will be handed over. A certificate will be awarded to all participants and runners-up, which will be handed over ceremonially in front of the leadership of the Faculty.

In addition, the I-III sections are used. Students who have placed in the first place will also receive a cash prize, which they will receive in the form of a scholarship (in 2020: I. place: 45 000 HUF, II. place: 25 000 HUF, III. place: 15 000 HUF, Special prize: 20 000 HUF).

In addition, first-place students from each section will be invited to the university award ceremony, where they will receive additional rewards.
